COVID-19 Free Style Activity

Please note: At any given time, there are only 10 skaters and 5 coaches on the ice during a FS session. Assigned skaters and coaches are the only patrons allowed in the building.

Please DO NOT Register without prior authorization from your personal coach. Anyone who is not authorized by their personal coach will be automatically denied from the day/time without notice.

Each session is 30 minutes in length and is in accordance with all federal, state and local COVID-19 mandates for Illinois Phase 3.

Practice ice freestyle sessions are for Basic 3 and above skaters. Lesson ice is for those in a private lesson for any level.

Please bring your OWN WATER BOTTLE. Patrons in the rink should not drink from the fountain; you may fill

REGISTRATION-SPD WebTrax

- Your personal coach will assign you a day & time.
- Register for activity (260417) with the specific day and time given to you by your personal coach. (You may NOT register for any other days or times.)
- There is not a discount for this activity (Fee: \$8.00 resident/&10 for non-resident)
- If you currently have punch pass(es), the Nelson Center will remove and credit your account. You may also use your credit to apply to this activity or other Park District programs.
- Reminder: You will still need to pay your personal coach's fee in addition to the activity fee

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All parents, coaches and skaters must wear a face mask in the facility. You are required to provide your own mask.

Drop-off procedures:

- Parents/Guardians will drop off skater at the circle drive.
 - If you need to assist your child to put on skates, you will park in the lot and walk up to the circle drive with your child.
- Any patron MUST have their mask on before exiting the car.
- Skater temperatures will be taken after exiting the car.
 - Temp of 100.4 or above means the skater cannot enter the facility
 - If the temp is normal, parent/guardian will be asked a series of questions from the SPD screening checklist.
- Once the skater has been screened (temp and questions), they will be sent to their assigned area. (Parents of little skaters must have a temp and be screened as well.)
- Once little skaters have skates on and are on the ice, parents must leave the facility.

Pick-up procedures:

- All skaters are required to *exit Rink 2 via the South ice rink door*
- All Skaters will wait at one of the chairs at the Sound end of the rink, remove skates and put on shoes.
- Parent/guardian should call 217-753-2800 ext. 2004 when you are ready to pick up your child.
- Parent/guardian of little skaters who need assistance to remove skates should call ahead and rink staff will let you in the southside emergency doors.

Social distancing of at least 6 feet apart will remain in place at ALL TIMES in the facility.
